ELIGIBILITY	Open to all registered USA Swimmers.
	 No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 302.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	 NI and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the NI BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	 Automatic timing will be used. Colorado Electronic Timing system with flat wall touch pads, horn starts, and scoreboard readouts.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	 All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per NI policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm-up, competition, and cool-down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	 The Meet Director and the NI Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, and swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	No athlete may enter in more than five (5) individual events.
	 No athlete will be permitted to compete unless the athlete is a member as provided in Article 302.
	No late entries will be accepted.
	• The Entry Coordinator reserves the right to return the entries in order to control the meet size.
	 Deck entries are permitted for athletes already in the meet, at the discretion, of the Meet Directors and Meet Referee. Deck entry fees will be \$5.00 per individual event.
	 Please email all entries to TJ Day at <u>starswimmingentries316@gmail.com</u>. You will receive confirmation that your entries have been entered or returned.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.

WARM-UP	The prescribed NI warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	All events will be PRE SEEDED. Programs will be available for coaches and officials only.
SCORING	Per the current USA Swimming Rulebook
AWARDS	 High Point Awards will be awarded to the TOP SWIMMER, male and female, in the following age groups: 8 and under, 9-Year-Olds, 10-Year-Olds, 11-year-Olds, and 12-year-Olds at the end of the series. Each team must designate a representative to pick up and sign for all awards for their team. Awards will NOT be mailed.
PROGRAMS	Digital copies will be posted on the STAR Swimming website at starswimming.org
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	 Admission charge of \$3.00 per person per session. Spectators will be allowed for this event. The meet will be accessible to all parents by a live stream provided by STAR Swimming using this YouTube link: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCOJtD68fNRG-6r3FneEdkng This link will also be posted on the STAR Website under the Meet Sheets tab. Volunteer opportunities will be available first to parents of the host team. If all positions are not filled, visiting teams will be contacted to fill the remaining volunteer positions.
OFFICIALS	 Officials interested in volunteering should contact Leo Gibbons at lcdjr1953@gmail.com. Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	Participating clubs are requested to provide timers.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	 Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director. Include in the subject of the email, "2024 Super Series #3-***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	 Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event. In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	 Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by NI and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.

	 Payment for entries from unattached swimmers not affiliated with a team must be received prior to the meet. Payment may be made by cash or check.
	• Entry fees are due with meet entry. Unpaid fees will be reported to the NI Administrative Office at the conclusion of the meet.
Available Medical Supervision/Equipment	 Medical assistance will be provided at the facility. If you require medical assistance, please notify a member of the meet staff. AED, backboard, & First Aid supplies at facility.
	Deck access is restricted to USA Swimming athletes, coaches, officials, and meet volunteers. Upon arrival, coaches will need to check in at the coaches check-in table, located in the hall way prior to the training room doors. Please make sure your deck pass/credentials are valid in order to gain access to the pool deck. You will not be granted access to the pool deck if your deck pass/ credentials are not complete. Once coaches check in, you will receive a wristband to wear for the remainder of the weekend.
LOCKER ROOMS	There will be "dry locker rooms" available for all coaches and officials. They will be the Men's & Women's Team Locker Rooms. Access to these locker rooms will only be accessed via the pool deck only. Athletes are NOT permitted in these locker rooms. Coaches, officials, meet personnel, and volunteers are NOT permitted in the athlete locker rooms at ANY TIME.
	All applicable adults participating in/or associate with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	Proper conduct on the part of all athletes and spectators is expected at all times, and will be enforced by coaches, meet marshals, officials, and college security. ANY ATHLETE found in the posted out of bounds areas, or using the green doors connecting the back pool to the lobby, will be barred from the remainder of the meet without recourse. Swimmers are not allowed to swim under the bulkhead. Disciplinary action will be immediate expulsion from the competition.
	The meet area is restricted to the pool and adjoining locker rooms, the adjacent hallway, balcony, and stands. Posted out-of-bounds areas include, but are not limited to: the emergency stairwells, the weight room, and the track/gymnasium areas. USE OF THE EMERGENCY DOORS BY ANYONE WITHOUT EXPRESSED PERMISSION TO USE THE CODE IS PROHIBITED. The USA Swimming Code of

Conduct will be enforced. No glass containers are allowed in the pool and locker room areas. Misbehavior, vandalism, and theft will not be tolerated and can result in being barred from participation in the meet.

Any athlete entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmers' legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Fly over starts will be used at this meet to help control meet duration.

No athlete will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is prohibited in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. *Deck changes are prohibited*.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach area, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Deck access is restricted to USA Swimming athletes, coaches, officials, and meet volunteers. All non-athlete members must have proof of registration or a credential while on deck and present them upon meet management request.

Deck pass is an acceptable proof of USA Swimming Membership.
