RULES	1 -	SA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.		
	All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the			
	provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that			
	they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of			

	this competition. No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted. In compliance with <i>USA Swimming</i>
	 Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per NI policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer
	entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools,
	athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	The Meet Director and the NI Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. All events are timed finals.
	Maximum individual events is 5
EVENT RULES	No deck entries will be accepted.
WARM-UP	The prescribed NI warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.

	Participating clubs are requested to provide timers. Entries should be submit to Meet Director.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	 Include in the subject of the email, "Skan Summer Kickoff - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files, include the training site in the subject of the email. Include in the entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event. In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact). Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted. Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted. The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director. Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by NI and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
